- We will learn the elements of a story such as characters, setting and events.

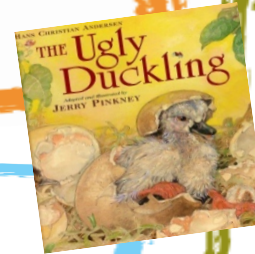


## Easter & Spring
